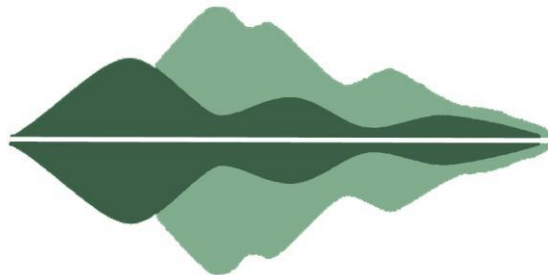

#### Korruption Kolsch

Golden ale by style. Korruption Kolsch has consistently been the number one ale ordered at the local brew pub. This is a pale straw colored beer with very pleasant melted barley flavors. This is not a very bitter beer. Kolsch features just enough hops to balance out the right malt flavors. This very easy drinking beer is a great introduction to craft brewed beers for the common domestic beer drinker  
5.0% A.B.V

#### Fremont

A combination of an English Pale Ale and an Ordinary Style bitter. The hops used in this beer are imported from England and added in generous amounts throughout the boil to create a complex hop profile. Brewed with crystal and caramel malted barley this beer features moderate sweetness and a noticeable hop character. Slightly bitter with a bit of floral hop aroma this is a good introduction to the more robust ale styles brewed. 5.5% A.B.V.
